2008 FOOTBALL SEASON PREVIEW

“The Hart of a Champion”

The Warren Central football team enters the 2008 season with a PURPOSE. To play the game with the same PASSION that brought the community 4 straight State Championships; and to play a style of football that demonstrates they are disciplined and have POISE when adversity looks them square in the eye. New Head Coach John Hart has made it clear that the only way to play the game is to incorporate the 3 P's into everything that our young men do. In the classroom, in the weight room, on the football field, and in the community the 2008 Warriors are focused and ready to show the Warrior Nation that they have “The Hart of a Champion”.

Defensive Outlook

On Defense the Warriors return 3 starters, a defensive coordinator who led the defense to 3 state titles from 2003-2005 in Steve Tutsie, and a ton of speed at every position. Mix these ingredients with some new, talented faces and the 2008 Warrior Defense will be a “Recipe for Destruction” on opposing offenses. The Warriors lose 3 players from last year's team who are now playing college football. Safety Anthony Weather (Univ. of Indianapolis), Defensive Tackle Justin Williams (Marian College), and Defensive End Marcus Watts (Marian College) will be missed, but look for new faces to emerge and play dominating Warrior football.

Defensive Line

The defensive tackle position looks to be solid in 2008. Senior

Joey Hampton returns with experience from last season, while newcomers Elijah Jones (Jr.), Malcolm Bunnell (Jr.), and Kris Harley (So.) are primed to join Coach Price's relentless rotation in the middle of the defense. As tough as it will be for opposing defenses to run inside, the going outside will not be any easier. The defensive end position looks to Seniors Tyler Woodson and Terrence Douglass for leadership and experience. Junior Keith Brown and Sophomore Kiaro Holts look to add important depth to this integral position. Coaches Corey Clark and Chris Price, both Warren Central graduates, will once again bring passion and intensity to our first line of defense.

Linebackers

The Linebacker Unit brings the most experience back in 2008 of any defensive position. They not only bring back some talented players, but are once again led by Justin Dixson. This very highly regarded young coach will lead the Whips and Rovers, as well as head up the Special Teams Unit. Alongside him will be a newcomer to the defensive side of the ball, inside linebacker coach Kyle Enright. He returns for his 5th season at Warren after spending the previous 4 on the offensive side of the ball.

Standout Rover Doron Sharpe (Sr.) returns after a great 2007 campaign that saw him earn numerous post-season honors. Next to him at the Brick position will be returning starter and team leader Erick Humphrey (Sr.).

Seniors Clifford Brooks and Zack Carroll will be joined by Juniors Lavelle Tealer, Brandon Almond, Jerry Boyd, Jeffrey Groves and Jamal Bolden as players trying to fill the other 2 linebacker spots. Speed and toughness are essential at this position and this year's LB's look like they have plenty of it.

Defensive Backs

Heading into the 2008 season there were many question marks in the secondary after losing 2 all-conference players in hard-hitting safety Anthony Weather and lockdown corner Jajuan Harris. But Division I recruit James Manuel (Jr.) had an outstanding summer and helped a few other players get better along the way. Manuel will see action at both corner and safety because of his versatility. No other player in the secondary has Varsity experience so this young group will have to gel quickly to become a great unit. Juniors Nate White and Richard Norris look to be mainstays at corner and safety respectively, along with super-sophomores Eric Robinson and Nick Temple. Senior Isaac Broadie will add experience to a very young group as he has worked extremely hard this summer to get on the field.

Newcomer Michael Brewer will coach the safeties while mastermind defensive coordinator Steve Tutsie will take charge of the corners.

Offensive Outlook

Offensively the Warriors are looking to reload with a bunch of new faces on the coaching staff led by

new Offensive Coordinator Nick Hart. Coach Hart led the Evansville Reitz football team last year to a 4A State Championship with a spread attack that should be scary for defenses to defend this year. With standout running backs Eric Williams and George Cheesebrough back in the mix after outstanding junior years, and 4 other returning starters back in TE Ed Hazelett (Sr.), WR Anthony Freeman (Sr.), and offensive linemen Matt Haynes (Sr.) and Michael Gegner (Jr.), the 2008 Warrior Offense should be very dangerous.

Quarterbacks/Running Backs

The loss of Iowa recruit and Indiana All-Star Jewel Hampton would be devastating for most teams, but not for Warren Central. As already stated, George Cheesebrough and Eric Williams will be relied upon to lead the Warriors on and off the field. These two backs may be the most versatile RB's that Warren Central High School has seen. Because of this, they will not only be counted on to put pressure on the defense by running the football, but also as dynamic receivers who make things happen on the perimeter. Shakir Bell (Jr.) will also play an integral role at the running back position while Desmond Harvey (Jr.) is slated to get the tough yardage as the bruising fullback in the offense. The signal caller this year, Derek Hart (Jr.), looks to add a dimension to the offense that the Warren faithful haven't seen for a while. The 6'4 gun-slinger can throw the football very well and the Warriors will look to use this to their advantage in the vaunted spread attack. The Varsity Running Backs will be coached by Mark Hartman and assisting him will be John Baker; both entering

their first year at Warren Central. 2nd year coach Brett Cooper will lead the quarterbacks again in 2008 and will also have the challenge of being the Junior Varsity Head Coach.

Wide Receivers/Tight Ends

"Big Ed" Hazelett (Sr.) returns to the offense and is looking to use his 6'8 and 265 pound frame to be a very uncommon dual-threat. Ed should be a mismatch for all opposing defenses as he can block like a lineman and catch passes like a wide receiver. This Division I recruit has played since his sophomore year and will be relied upon to be a leader on the offense. Backing up "Big Ed" will be another big-bodied TE, Ja'juan Keyes (6'3 215-Jr.). At WR the Warriors return one starter from 2007 in Anthony Freeman (Sr.). This former walk-on has continued to be one of the hardest workers in the program and is a great example for our younger players. Other receivers looking to make plays in 2008 are speedy junior Maurice Magee and senior Jamal Hampton. They will be coached this year by 2nd year Varsity coach Kyle Akers. Hall of Fame coach Dave Enright will assist him.

Offensive Line

Another experienced group in 2008 is the Offensive Line. Senior Matt Haynes and Junior Michael Gegner are returning starters, while Senior Ashton Akers and Junior Brandon Blackburn started a few games in 2007 as well. Joining them will

be Zach Graves (Jr.), Vincent Duerson (Sr.), and super sophomore Jamoni Gentry (6'4 345). The loss of starters Zach Porter (Marian College) and Asrie Dixon (Joliet C.C.) are significant, but this year's line is eager to continue the road grading tradition that Warrior Nation has grown accustomed to. Three coaches will share the duties on the O-Line this year and all three are new to the program. Jason Youngs and Ryan Barclay will be the Varsity line coaches; while former Warren Central standout and O-Line Mr. Football Mike Clevenger will lead the JV lineman.



Special Teams

Assistant Head Coach Justin Dixon will once again orchestrate this often over-looked, but VERY important aspect of the game. Some teams try not to let their own special teams lose them the game, but at Warren Central, Coach Dixon makes this unit a weapon. Sharing the kicking duties this year are Seniors Tommy Martin and Zack Sparks. Both have Varsity experience and should give our kicking game a boost. Taking care of the punting duties will be Eric Williams and Tommy Martin. Returning punts and kicks will be the very dangerous threesome of George Cheesebrough, Shakir Bell, and Maurice Magee. Brandon Almond and Ashton Akers will tag-team the snapping duties while back-up QB Brandon Smith will be the holder on field goals and extra points.

ATHLETIC INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF STUDENT-ATHLETES AT W.C.H.S.

The Athletic Department is charged with the responsibility of helping your son or daughter to be the best possible student, athlete, citizen, and competitor within their potential. We will conduct an educationally sound program that will develop an athlete's fundamentals, techniques, strategies, and sportsmanship for competition. It is our hope that your family will leave Warren with many fond memories of accomplishment in every phase of athletics. We want your son/daughter to be a better person because they competed at Warren and we feel confident Warren will be better because they were here.

Athletic Policy: The Student-Athlete Handbook has been carefully prepared, documented, and adopted by our school board. It clearly states our policies, rules, and procedures. Because this information is vital, we ask every parent and student to sign that they have read and understood the information contained in the handbook. Athletes cannot practice until this has been completed & signed by student, parent, and doctor.

Channel of Communication: There will be times when clarifications are needed, questions answered, requests made, and information exchanged. It is the desire of each coach and the Athletic Department to impart accurate information. If parents have a question concerning their daughter/son, they are to first contact the head coach of the child's respective sport. If, after talking with the coach, there needs to be further discussion parents should contact the Athletic Director. All parties must keep in mind that firmness, fairness, and hard decisions are a part of athletics. It is important to get all possible information before decisions are made.

Contest Dates: The athletic schedule is contained in the schedule booklet available to every resident of Warren Township. All coaches are to hand out a complete varsity/reserve sport schedule to each of their athletes.

Practice attendance: It is evident that athletes cannot get better without consistent practice. Our athletes are expected to be present at all practices. Practice is not optional for an athlete. Only the coach can adjust practice schedules. Practice schedules are available from coaches; they are not kept on file at the Athletic Office.

Interest Clubs: Several sports have a group of parents who exist to enhance their son or daughter's athletic experience. These booster groups are under the guidance of each head coach and the athletic director. The coaching staff and parents of each particular group govern their activities.

Post-Season Events: Award presentations, dinners, pitch-ins, picnics, and other get-togethers are sometimes held at the close of an athletic team's season. These events are not required. They are held at the discretion of each sport.

Rainouts/Postponements: Decisions concerning rainouts and/or postponements will normally be made at the last minute. This is to insure our making the best decision. Our athletes have practiced hard to compete and we want to attempt to let them compete whenever safely possible. The Athletic Office can be called for this information between 2:30 and 3:00 p.m.

Admission Charges: the high school principals of Marion County have determined admission charges:

Special Warren Central Pass Prices:

Adult All-Sport Pass:	\$40	Entitles the adult entrance to all home athletic events except the IHSAA and Marion County Tournament contests.
Student Activity Pass:	\$30	Entitles the Student entrance to all home athletic events except ISHAA and Marion County Tournament contests.
Varsity Letter Pass:	\$15	Any athlete who has earned his/her letter in a sport can purchase this pass, which will allow them into all home athletic contest except ISHAA and Marion County Tournament contests.

Activity Bus: The activity bus normally runs two times after school. The first bus leaves at approximately 4:15 p.m. and the late bus leaves at approximately 5:30 p.m. Weather conditions and early dismissal will affect the running of these buses. There are no activity buses during vacation practices or after night contests.
