Varsity Head Coach Hagist is starting his 11th season as the head volleyball coach and physical education teacher at Warren Central. His volleyball teams have compiled a record of 209-114 under his guidance. This season Warren will compete with some of the best teams in the state. Seven seniors return from a team that went 20-12 last year and with their leadership it looks to be another exciting season for Warren Volleyball.
