LEADERSHIP TRAINING FOR TEAM CAPTAINS – GEORGE TAHAN AD, BELMONT HILL AND BILL WHITMORE AD, MILTON ACADEMY WILL BE DISCUSSING THE TOPIC OF HOW TO SUPPORT AND DEVELOP STUDENT LEADERSHIP IN ATHLETICS.

MIDDLE SCHOOL AD ROUND TABLE - MARK JACKSON AD, DEDHAM COUNTRY DAY AND MIKE HEALY AD, RECTORY SCHOOL WILL LEAD A DISCUSSION ON CONTEMPORARY ISSUES PERTAINING TO MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETICS.

SPORTSMANSHIP – DICK MARR WILL PRESENT AN INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP EXPLORING (1) THE THEME OF SPORTSMANSHIP AND HOW THIS TOPIC IS INTERRELATED WITH (2) GENDER DIFFERENCES: THE DIFFERENT CONCERNS, STRATEGIES, AND/OR VALUES COACHES MUST EMPLOY WHEN WORKING WITH YOUNG WOMEN. ATTENDANTS WILL BE ASKED TO ANALYZE A NUMBER OF HYPOTHETICAL SITUATIONS RELATING TO THESE ISSUES. PAST AND CURRENT SIGNIFICANT LITERATURE WILL BE INTEGRATED INTO THE PRESENTATION, WITH THE HOPE THAT THOSE ATTENDING MAY UTILIZE THE HANDOUTS WITH THEIR COACHES AT THEIR RESPECTIVE SCHOOLS.

LEAGUE MINDER – A REPRESENTATIVE FROM LEAGUE MINDER WILL MAKE A PRESENTATION REGARDING THE ADVANTAGES OF UTILIZING LEAGUE MINDER SOFTWARE TO OPERATE YOUR ENTIRE ATHLETIC OFFICE.

SPORT AND SOCIETY – A REPRESENTATIVE FROM NORTHEASTERN UNIVERSITY WILL MAKE A PRESENTATION ON THEIR MENTORS IN VIOLENCE PROTECTION (MVP) PROGRAM. FOUNDED IN 1993 BY NORTHEASTERN'S CENTER FOR THE STUDY OF SPORT IN SOCIETY, THIS PROGRAM MOTIVATES STUDENT-ATHLETES TO PLAY A CENTRAL ROLE IN SOLVING PROBLEMS THAT HISTORICALLY HAVE BEEN CONSIDERED "WOMEN'S ISSUES": RAPE, BATTERING AND SEXUAL ABUSE.
