The selection committee will review all applications and select two or more recipients. Those awarded the scholarships will be notified by telephone and letter, and may be invited to be honored at the WSSAAA Spring Convention in April. All applicants will be notified of the decision no later than May 1st, and scholarships will be submitted to the college upon enrollment.

Selection Criteria

- Only completed applications postmarked by the deadline will be considered. Deadline is March 1st.
- The applicant must be a graduating high school senior and the child or legal ward of a current WSSAAA member.
- The applicant shall have a minimum 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average; transcripts must accompany the application.
- The applicant must have participated in high school athletics or activities some time during grades 9-12. Attach a description of this participation to your application.
- The applicant shall have demonstrated service to their school and/or community and good citizenship. A description of these activities should be included.
- The applicant must attach an essay on the listed topic with their application. This will be judged on content, writing style and mechanics.
- The applicant must include letters of recommendation from at least two school officials (principal, athletic director, coaches, teachers, counselors, or other school officials). The person making the recommendation may not be related to the applicant, nor a WSSAAA board member.
