

Why This Clinic?

VANCE WALBERG — UNIVESITY OF MASSUCHUSETTS

One of the most innovative minds in the sport of basketball brings his approach and philosophy to our clinic. Walberg is in his first year as an assistant coach with Massachusetts. Walberg has been widely credited for bringing his dribble-drive system to the sport and it has succeeded

at the highest levels in working with Memphis coach John Calipari. Walberg makes the move back east after 40 years on the west coast as a successful head coach for more than 30 years on the college, junior college and high school level.

Walberg, who served as the head coach at Pepperdine University from 2006-08, is well-known for his system which was chronicled in Sports Illustrated in February 2008. Known as AASAA (Attack, Attack, Skip, Attack, Attack), Walberg spent 17 seasons building winning programs at Clovis West High School and Fresno City College prior to coaching the Waves for a year-and-a-half. "Shoot, shoot and shoot some more," said Walberg in describing his system. "It's really very simple. What we do is I spread you out and attack the different gaps. We call it AASAA - Attack, Attack, Skip, Attack, Attack. Everybody gets a big plus out of it. It starts with the guards. The first thing we want them to do is come down and look to score. It's up to the guards to be able to break their man down. Once the breakdown process begins and whoever helps, that's where the kick goes. If we struggle, we reverse things and put it inside and it's time for the big guys to take over. It's really very simple."

In four years as head coach at Fresno City College from 2003-06, Walberg compiled a 133-11 (.924) record, including a perfect 34-0 mark and the California state community college championship in 2005. Using his AASAA offensive system, his teams regularly scored more than 100 points per game.

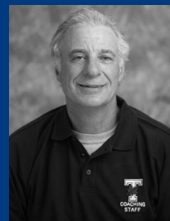


LARRY SHYATT — UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA

One of the great minds in college basketball, Larry Shyatt was added to the Florida staff by Billy Donovan on May 10, 2004 where he is now Associate Head Coach. Shyatt's impact was an immediate one, as he helped take the Gators from 11th in the SEC in points per game allowed in 2003-04 to third in 2004-05, claiming the

school's first SEC Tournament title along the way. The trend continued in 2005-06, as the Gators finished second in the league in fewest points surrendered and claimed the school's first national title while taking the SEC Tournament for the second straight year. In 2006-07, the Gators surrendered just 62.6 points per game, the fewest by a Gator squad in over half a century.

Each of the past two years Shyatt has been honored by the Basketball Times as the top-rated assistant coach in the nation. Shyatt brings over 30 years of basketball coaching experience to Florida, having spent time as a head coach at both Clemson and Wyoming. In six seasons as a head coach, five at Clemson and one at Wyoming, Shyatt posted a record of 89-93, including a trip to the NIT Championship game in 1999 in his first season with the Tigers. Shyatt has spent time as an assistant coach at Utah, Cleveland State, New Mexico, Providence Friars and Clemson.



MIKE KATZ — UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO

Mike Katz is the current head coach of the University of Toronto. Katz has returned Toronto to nationally prominence and last year was named CIS National Coach of the Year. He brought a wealth of experience and past success from his time at Humber College and with the Canadian National

Team to Toronto.

At Humber College Katz led the men's basketball team for 19 seasons. His overall record at Humber was an impressive 503-175. During that time, he led the Hawks to the OCAA Final Four every year, winning seven provincial championships and five national titles while also producing seven All-Canadian players. Katz is also a four-time OCAA Coach of the Year and a three-time CCAA Coach of the Year award winner. Katz was also an assistant coach of the Canadian National Basketball squad, and took part in the 2000 Olympic Games and World Championships in 1993 and 2002. In 1997, he guided Canada's team at the World University Games in Sicily to a silver medal. Katz was also the head coach of the Ontario provincial team from 1986 to 1989, capturing one gold and one silver medal.

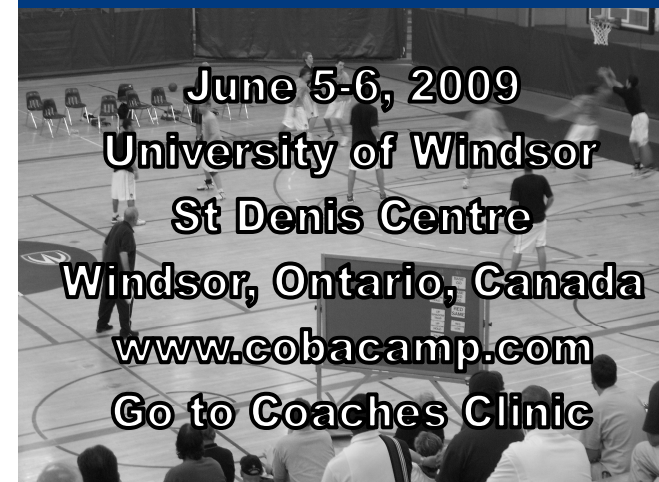
