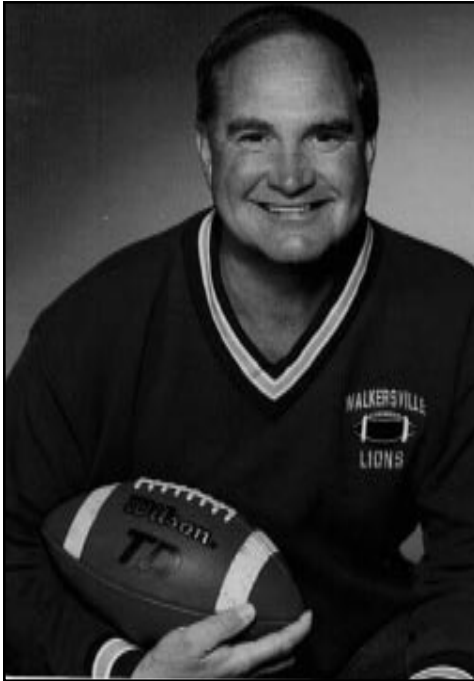




2007/08 Hall of Fame Inductee

Dave Schrodel Walkersville



A Frederick County native, Dave, played High School football at Frederick High School where he was selected All-League Center his senior year. A graduate of Frostburg State class of 1966 he played football for three years and was captain his senior year.

Dave has been coaching in the State for 34 years. He started at Bladensburg High in 1967 under coach Chuck Brown. In 1968 he came to Frederick County and served as an assistant at Westminster with head coach Jim Head. In 1969 he went to Thomas Johnson High School under head coach Jack Molesworth. In 1971 he became the Head Coach at Thomas Johnson High.

He served as Head Coach for 14 years at TJ and Walkersville High Schools, where he compiled a record of 122-30. He had 3 undefeated teams (1971 TJ, 1988 and 1992 Walkersville) and 4 state playoff teams. His 1971 team at TJ was selected "Number One" by the Baltimore Sun. During his years at Walkersville 1986-1992, Dave's teams were 67—15 and won 4 League Championships.
