

Athletic Policy

To All Parents and Student-Athletes,

Student participation in athletics is a strong component of the High School atmosphere and community. Athletics at Franklin High School have maintained a long lasting tradition of excellence. Our goal is to educate student-athletes and have them aspire to reach leadership roles in the school house and the community.

Any negative representation of the school or community's image will not be tolerated in our athletic programs. Athletics at Franklin High School are strictly an extracurricular activity and regarded as a tremendous privilege. This privilege inherits an added responsibility for each student-athlete to model sportsmanship, self-discipline, and most importantly academic well being.

Student Athletes must meet all Baltimore County, Maryland Public Secondary School Athletic Association (MPSSAA), Franklin High School Student Handbook, Respective Team, Franklin High School Administrative Staff, and Athletic Policy guidelines and rules to maintain participation in their respective activity.

Non-compliance with any part of the above mentioned guidelines and rules may result in the suspension or permanent removal of a team member from participation.

Athletic Policy

1. Student-Athletes will maintain and meet all academic requirements.
(Students must dress properly in physical education classes on game days to be eligible for participation)
2. Student-Athletes will abide by the school's academic honor code.
3. Student-Athletes will meet all attendance requirements of their teachers, coaches, and school.
(Athletes must be in attendance on game day for the entire school day to be eligible for participation. Only excused lateness, early dismissal, or approved reasons by the Principal, are exemptions)
4. Student-Athletes will report any and all injuries to their coaches or the athletic director.
5. Student-Athletes will be personally and financially responsible for all equipment and uniforms issued to them and will immediately return all team items to the coach as soon as the season is completed.
6. Student-Athletes and Parents will not demonstrate poor-sportsmanship behavior at any practice, scrimmage, or game involving Franklin High School Athletics.
(Non-conformance of the sportsmanship guidelines will result possible suspension or removal of a team member, or the removal and possible banning of a spectator from future athletic contests involving Franklin High School)
